Generic writing happens because the AI has no idea who you are. Give it a room it never leaves. Three small files, about fifteen minutes.

01 voice.md — five rules

Write how you actually talk. Five plain bullets:

1. I sound like [_____].
2. I never use these words: [_____].
3. Sentence length: [short / varied].
4. I always [_____].
5. I never [_____].

02 example.md — one you're proud of

Paste one post, email, or paragraph you like. Tell it: "This is the standard. Match this voice." The AI learns more from one good example than ten instructions.

03 formats.md — the shapes

Define what you output:

```
LinkedIn = hook line, one lesson, soft CTA.  
IG caption = 1 hook + 3 short lines.  
Script = cold-open question, then teach.
```

04 The generate command

"Using my voice, example and formats: topic = [x]. Give me a script, a LinkedIn post and an IG caption. Then I'll tell you what's wrong and you keep the correction."

Honest note: this doesn't remove you. It drafts in minutes; the judgment stays yours. Feed it corrections for two weeks, that's when it clicks.
